REVISTA DE METALURGIA goes online

The CSIC Editorial Board has agreed to publish only the online edition of the Journal, starting with the first issue of volume 50 (1), 2014. As such, the printed edition and its associated subscriptions will be suppressed. Consequently, *REVISTA DE METALURGIA* is adapted to the new technologies and online forms of publishing, as already implemented by numerous scientific journals, aimed at greater dissemination of content and economic sustainability.

The content of the online edition of the journal will be made available in three formats: PDF, XHTML and XML tagged according to NLM Journal Publishing 3.0 standards. The PDF and XHTML file are oriented towards printing and reading of content on computer screens and digital tablets, and accessing full text by search engines. The tagged XML file is basically aimed at the preservation and automatic access to the content and tagged metadata in accordance with existing documental standards.

Access to individual articles will remain open on the Journal's website (http://revistademetalurgia.revistas.csic.es), under a Creative Commons Attribution, non-Commercial (by-nc) license.

Full issues published by the journal in PDF—similar in form and content to the printed edition-will be available for individual purchase and electronic subscription through different distribution platforms. This will facilitate the possibility of maintaining the full collection of the journal in digital format.
